Then stop for a refreshing cup of tea and cake at the café, browse the shop and meet Scramble the cat – there's something for all the family.

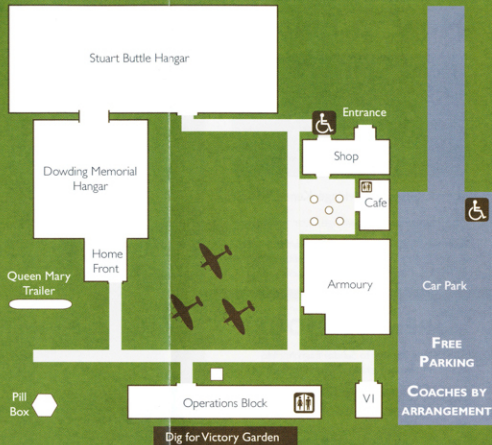
